Thank you for joining us on this self-guided circular walk to discover the Public Art of Enfield Town. The walk features over 15 different artworks, some quite old and some very new.

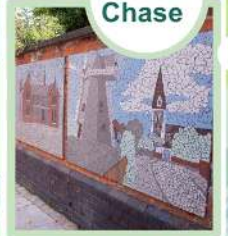
The journey starts right here at the Station with a new community driven artwork by local artist Kremena Dimitrova and humorous pieces by Shaypress.

- X Enfield Chase Station   - Platform 2 - *Kremena Dimitrova* - mural; and three digital artworks by *Shaypress*.
- Outside the Station - *Debbie Dean* - Three mosaics of lost buildings.

- X Chase Green   - Wall behind trees - Street art by *Shaypress* - The Chase.



- X Chase Green Gardens    - *Wendy Taylor CBE* - The Millennium Fountain sun dial sculpture.



- X Enfield Town Park       - South west corner - *Joe Robinson* - Enfield Living Memorial - steel and trees.


- X Dugdale Arts Centre - Cecil Road    - *W & A Mussett* - Enfield Beast, changing art, exhibitions, museum, film and live performances.




- X Genotin Road near Metaswitch (Rear of St Anne's High School for Girls) - *Debbie Dean* - The Queens Hall mosaic.


- X Civic Centre - Outside the entrance - *Richard Bentley-Cloughton's* bronze Enfield Beast on a pillar; Also a bronze cherub holding a fish. If you get an opportunity to go inside there are many artworks including a local history mural by *Gerald Holton*.




- X The Charter Market   - Occasional performances and art and craft stalls on market days.

- X The Town   - In front of Barclays Bank - *Hasan Bölücek* - Alevi Faith Art Crossing.

- X Fountain Island  - 1885 Granite fountain. An occasional space for food and entertainment.

- X Palace Gardens    - Between a well know store and a shoe shop - *Anna Nicolò* - a Stroll through Enfield Town - Mural.

- X Little Park Gardens  - Soon to be transformed as a small art led square next to the Post Office.

- Library Green    - *Lauren Baker's* Neon, The Trees are watching, was damaged and removed in 2024. An occasional entertainment space.

If you have time please visit **Gordon Hill Station**: a short walk or train journey away.
